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## ***JOURNAL OF CRUSTACEAN BIOLOGY: INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS***

**Scope.** The *Journal of Crustacean Biology* (JCB) is the official journal of The Crustacean Society (TCS). JCB is a peer-reviewed, bimonthly scientific journal containing articles of broad interest on the biology of crustaceans and other marine arthropods and pertinent TCS announcements. Articles are published in English only. See current online issues here:

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*Journal of Crustacean Biology* welcomes the submission of reviews that intend to cover timely research topics on any aspect of the biology of crustaceans, aiming to survey previously published data, update research, and highlight uncharted territories and future directions. Two types of reviews are published: short and regular-length reviews. Manuscripts for short reviews should not exceed 35 pages (excluding figures); review manuscripts of over 35 pages will be considered as one of the regular-length reviews.

## GENETICS AND GENOMICS SUBMISSIONS

*Journal of Crustacean Biology* will consider manuscripts on gene cloning studies only if they can improve our understanding on some aspects of crustacean biology. We prefer including functional studies and manipulative experiments that can elucidate the physiological functions of the gene concerned, other than only presenting expression profiles of the gene in different tissues and/or life history stages of the species.

## RESEARCH NOTES

Manuscripts for Research Notes should not exceed 12 pages. The format, style, and sequence of material must be the same as that of regular research articles (see below) except that the

text itself will not be subdivided into sections (“Introduction,” “Material and Methods,” etc.). The abstract must be short and concise.

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The text should be concise and clear and contain no footnotes. The original manuscript must be double-spaced, leaving margins of at least one inch. Please insert double spacing above headings, number pages consecutively at the top right-hand corner, and use 12 pt Times New Roman font. Manuscripts must be uploaded as an editable Word document. Correspondence regarding the format and style of manuscripts should be sent to the Editor-in-Chief.

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- 1) “Running head” (in low-case letters, starting with the name of author(s) or authors plus *et al.*, and an abbreviated title)
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- 8) main text
- 9) “SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIAL” list with short description for each item as S1 Figure, S2 Table, S3 Figure, etc.
- 10) “FUNDING” (“None declared” if there was no funding)
- 11) “ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS” (including anonymous reviewers)
